### What About Sin and Redemption?

Within the world of Potentia, Sin has a totally different meaning. In typical terms it means "violation of a religious/moral code of conduct." In Potentia terms it means "violation of the Laws of Potential."

The significant difference here is the fact that a moral code is humanistically based. This means it is made and/or interpreted by humankind. It is presumptuous of humans to declare they can represent, fairly and purely, the rules of a higher authority. This is especially so when information concerning said rules is subject to interpretation. How could any human presume to know the mind of God without an absolute form of communication?

Such is not the case with Potentia. Absolute, fundamental laws, derived from Nature and Science, and expressed in conjunction with theological and philosophical propositions, are the framework for this approach. Interpretation, analysis and judgment become clinical and objective versus subjective and partial. However, there is another key distinction between the two "sin concepts". With Potentia, sin implies wrong direction as well as weakness, in the sense of Achievement. Religious/moral sins mean either an evil act or unpure state of being. In Potentia, sin really doesn't exist, per se. Violation becomes more of a cause and effect matter. "Wrongness" is viewed as directed toward constructive criticism.

Redemption in Potential terms is accomplished by overcoming weakness through achievement.
